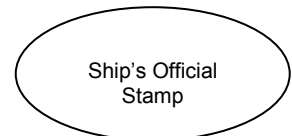

Description of Duties:

1. Day work within main machinery and boiler spaces.
2. Regular watch-keeping on auxiliary machinery (eight hours in every twenty-four hour period).
3. Regular watch-keeping on main propelling machinery (eight hours in every twenty-four hour period).
 - (a) in full charge;
 - (b) as first assistant to the senior in full charge.
4. Regular UMS practices.
 - (a) centralized control room;
 - (b) full or partial automation;
 - (c) facility to operate machinery in the unattended mode for a significant proportion of each twenty-four hour period.
